

The Red Rock Road Mountain Bike Trail is a meandering 10 mile trail through the Juniper Creek Primitive Area in Blackwater River State Forest in Santa Rosa County, Florida. Parking is available at the bridge crossing Juniper Creek at Red Rock Road. The trail head is just before the smaller bridge and is marked with a 4x4 post. The Red Rock Trail climbs and descends a long hill for about a mile before crossing a drainage ditch and continuing to the main loop. The main loop can be ridden either direction and is marked by yellow blazes although due to recent logging the blazes may be far apart. There are signs at all the intersections and there are several opportunities to bail out. There is no potable water in the area so be sure to bring plenty. Bug spray is also recommended to protect against ticks and chiggers. This is a primitive area so be prepared to see wildlife, including venomous snakes. Please do your part to help maintain the trail by volunteering for trail maintenance and reporting trail obstructions to the Pensacola Off Road Cyclists (PORC.org). Contact the Division of Forestry at 957-6140 for main gate access. Please follow the IMBA 'Rules of the Trail'. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK!

Directions from Milton: From Truly Spokin' (near the intersection of Hwy 90 and Stewart St.) go north on Stewart St. to Hwy 191. Turn right on Hwy 191 and go for 11.3 miles to Red Rock Road. Turn right on Red Rock Road and go about 3 miles to Juniper Creek. Park here.
